REBIRTH

CONCEPT STATEMENT

Rebirth explores the idea of a major shoreline intervention and minor infrastructure intervention, with the focus of the design reimagining an underutilized road that divides the park along the historic shoreline at Smith Cove. The design incorporates the re-orientation of several natural ecologies including the integration of the City's city-wide container planting plan to the intertidal zone. Events and gatherings could be facilitated through the natural features stepping down from the boardwalk.

CONCEPT STATEMENT


Reflection explores the idea of a medium shoreline intervention and major infrastructure intervention that shifts 22nd Ave to the West property line and proposes a connection to the future Magnuson Bridge. The SAC drive is shown as a multi-use park drop-off and parking loop. Connections are made up to the Kingside neighborhood and to the historic view of the site through a linear horizontal (railroad) extending out over the water. The shoreline intervention includes the creation of additional island structures to protect the historical view and create an experiential aspect of low tide and via water rest.




