The Executive Director of the City of Seattle, Civil Service Commission hereby enters the following:

BACKGROUND

By memo dated December 4, 2012, the Director of Human Services Department ("the Department") imposed a two week suspension of Valerien Landicho (Appellant). On December 5, 2012, Appellant filed an appeal with the Civil Service Commission regarding the discipline taken by his employer.

The Commission assigned the appeal to CSC Hearing Officer, Chris Mathews and the hearing was conducted on March 6 & 7 and April 4 & 5, concluding on the 5th. Appellant represented himself and the Department was represented by Sr. HR Specialists Meenakshi Vedantham and DonYeta Villavaso-Madden.

On June 26, 2013, Chris Mathews, CSC Hearing Officer, issued the Findings and Decision in this matter affirming the discipline imposed upon Appellant.

At its July 17, 2013 monthly meeting the Commission reviewed the Findings and Decision of the Hearing Officer and affirmed the decision to uphold the two week suspension of the Appellant.

ORDER

The Civil Service Commission hereby dismisses this appeal with prejudice.
