




E. Republican St.



Republican St. named by John Denny, an ardent Whig, to honor the new name of the Party.

(School name honors states most beloved and prominent historian; founded Mountaineer Club. Use of name with playfield discontinued by Park Board action - 1955) (Original school on site was named "Campfellow")

E. Thomas St.

Thomas St. named for Thomas Denny, by John Denny, his father.

(From 1908-1925/1935 the Seattle (Horse) Riding & Driving Academy was located on the east half of the ballfield and was a continuous source of "barn nuisances.")

John St. was named for two Johns - the father of Arthur and David Denny and the son of David, John B.

* The original playground of 1.68 Ac. was given to the city in 1906, the first land given for playground; gift of Mrs. (Wm. Winlock) Mary M. Miller (firm of "capitalists" with her sons) in commemoration of her boy Pendleton. Another son, Winlock W., was regent of U. of W. for 37 years, among first of forest conservationists; named his son - Pendleton. Upon enlargement of Miller P.G. in 1953 (L.I.D. \$153,201²) the School + Park entered into a joint-use Agreement in 1955 wherein the Park Dept. developed + maintains playfield, school sharing cost; joint-use of bldg. + p.f. by permit. This Agreement "extended" in 1962 with the construction of the COMMUNITY CENTER -


