New portion transf. to Water Dept. 1935 for reservoir (150,000 cu. ft.)

Unused portion developed as playground by permit: 1947 (11 Ac.)

Playfield name taken from Golf Course which  
was named to honor the 3rd President.

Short 9 (originally opened 1922) closed in 1941 with  
installation of anti-aircraft guns; playfield - site of  
creation Camp: large shop building was (Tennis Courts 142)  
part of Army Camp.  
amp skating rink. Short 9, Driving Range,  
P.F. restuffed w/ construction of school and of  
Veteran's Hospital (site given for hospital).  
Playfield developed in Agreement with  
School Board - 1955 - for joint use of  
field + school facilities.
