- Instant discounts from participating distributors for efficient LED lighting and heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) equipment.
- Rebates for the purchase of qualified energy-saving equipment.
- Cash incentives for lighting, HVAC, refrigeration, and building envelope retrofits customized to your project.
- Performance-based incentives for holistic Operations and Maintenance (O&M) and capital equipment upgrades.

City Light pays up to 70% of project cost based on estimated kilowatt-hour savings for your project.

Customers are eligible for FREE site assessments and technical advice to help identify energy-saving measures that cut operating costs. City Light offers a comprehensive portfolio of energyefficiency programs and multiple pathways to receive rebates and incentive dollars.

Instant discounts: Lighting to Go instant discounts are applied at purchase when you shop at participating distributors across the region, so there's no pre-approval or paperwork needed. HVAC+ Program — works with distributors to improve access to high-performance, high-efficiency equipment for all Seattle City Light commercial and industrial customers. AHRI Certified™ high-efficiency equipment is readily available from participating distributors at competitive prices for customer projects, including retrofit, new construction, and even emergency replacement.

Rebates: City Light offers rebates that do not require pre-approval. To initiate an application, submit qualified purchases within 90 days of purchase date in our online form for "Simple Business Rebates".

"Custom" or "Calculated" Incentives: Incentives for many upgrades are dependent on the specific installation at your facility. Most "custom" incentives are quickly determined once project details are processed through an incentive calculator and our Energy Management Analysts (EMAs).

Performance-Based Incentives

Incentives for improvements that involve multiple systems or have complex interactive effects that complicate estimating energy savings, but typically reduce consumption by 5% - 15% or more.

The Existing Building Commissioning (EBCx) program provides incentives for retro-commissioning (RCx) or monitoring-based commissioning (MBCx) of your building's existing systems. Commissioning optimizes building systems to improve occupant comfort and energy efficiency. Participants receive a guaranteed base incentive and are eligible for additional incentives for meeting a performance threshold.

The Deep Retrofit Pay for Performance (P4P) program provides incentives for installing energy-efficient capital measures. Customers can receive incentive payments over three or five years for verified energy savings. P4P pays a set incentive amount for the total energy saved at the electric meter, rather than separate incentives for different measures. This allows for more flexible and creative projects, helping you to find even more ways to save

The HVAC Major Controls measure offers financial incentives for completing a comprehensive HVAC controls upgrade. There is a guaranteed base incentive after installation and successful verification. An additional performance incentive is given after the controls are in place for at least 10-12 months and the minimum savings target is met.

Receive incentive check!

Supplemental Incentives offset the administrative costs of efficiency project development and implementation. These incentives can increase funding by up to 20%.

Designate an Energy Project Manager (EPM) to champion and coordinate multiple energy efficiency projects in your organization and receive an additional \$0.025/ kWh saved on top of the incentive earned by your efficiency upgrade.

Project Development Incentive (PDI) funding provided to offset administrative costs of participating in City Light's incentive program. Eligibility dependent on date project is completed.

Renewable Energy Services — City Light provides carbon-neutral electricity with net-zero impact. Still we recognize that businesses want additional options for renewable energy to meet their sustainability goals. We offer several options for the purchase of renewable energy credits, installation of solar at your business, and electrification of your fleet.

Eligibility

To be eligible for funding for a commercial or industrial retrofit project, the customer must have a nonresidential electricity account in City Light's service area. To receive an incentive (excluding rebates and instant discounts), equipment installation cannot begin, and products/equipment shall not be purchased, until the project has been reviewed and approved by City Light and there is a signed Participation Agreement with the customer. This program may change without notice and is subject to the availability of funds.
