I do not believe that I am guilty of the offense(s) with which I am charged. I have reviewed the discovery (police reports, witness statements, etc.) with my attorney. Based on the evidence which the Prosecuting Authority will offer at trial, I believe that there is a substantial likelihood that I would be found guilty following a fair and impartial trial. Consequently, I wish to take advantage of the Prosecutor's sentence recommendation and/or reduction in charges by asking the Court to enter an **Alford Plea** on my behalf. I understand that this plea will result in a conviction as if I had entered into a standard guilty plea or had been convicted following trial. The Court may review the Affidavit of Probable Cause or Police Incident Report# _____ to determine whether a factual basis exists to support this plea.
