


Licensed family child care is all across the city with the greatest density in Southeast Seattle.









City of Seattle and Family Child Care Homes

- There are 372 Seattle FCC programs with the capacity to serve over 3,000 children;
- FCC program are more likely to serve children of color and first-generation immigrants than centers;
- 116, or 31%, of Seattle FCC providers speak Somali as a first language;
- Other prominent languages include Spanish (39 homes), Arabic (38 homes), Amharic (20 homes), French (12 homes), Vietnamese (10 homes), and Chinese (9 homes).





Current City of Seattle FCC Initiatives

SPP Family Child Care Pilot

• Pilot started in September of 2017 and will help the city understand how to support FCC owners so they can provide Seattle Preschool Program services.

PCHP Family Child Care Pilot

• Pilot started in September of 2017 and uses a home visiting model with family child care owners.

HighScope Training – Early Learning Academy • Training provides FCC owners/operators with HighScope curriculum instruction over a 3-year period.

Child Care Comprehensive Program

• Family child care providers participating in our CCCP program are eligible to accept city subsidy vouchers and receive city supports.

Future Family Child Care Initiatives

Investments from the Sugar Sweetened Beverage Tax

• Up to \$2.5M to increase Birth-3 supports, including nursing and coaching.

Family Child Care Study • Will be completed in the beginning of 2018, with FCC Advisory Committee guidance. Intended to inform DEEL's strategic plan for supporting FCCs.

Family and Education Levy Renewal

• DEEL anticipates continuing the FCC Pilot for the Seattle Preschool Program into the new levy.
