Invoicing – December 2, 2019


- Campaigns received \$2,454,475, representing 98,179 redeemed vouchers.

Democracy Vouchers – November 30, 2023

- We have received 118,185 vouchers, representing 30,597 residents.
 - Paper – 51%
 - Online – 19%
 - Campaign Forms – 30%



- By December 2, 2019, we had received 147,100 vouchers, representing 38,085 residents.
