### Candidate Introductions


The first request to submit Candidate Introductions has been sent. Additional requests are sent periodically until the final date to become a DVP candidate has passed (May 23).

Candidates are invited to submit one, 200-word introduction and photograph to inform Seattle residents about their candidacy. They are translated into 19 languages and made available on our website.


Introductions are followed by one of these two statements:



#### Your Money, Your Choice

Democracy Vouchers are a way for Seattle residents to make financial contributions to candidates they support in Seattle City elections.

The program is funded by a voter-approved property tax, costing the average property owner about \$8 per year.





#### How and when should I use them?



On each voucher you are ready to use, write the candidate's name on the top line, then sign your name and date on the bottom line.

You can assign your vouchers to one or more candidates.

Candidates need your support early to be competitive, so be sure to use your vouchers as soon as you find candidates you like.

Contributing to a campaign, including using Democracy Vouchers, is public information. This means your name (and possibly your address), who you contributed to, and the amount will be posted on the internet.



The first of two bus ad campaigns will begin February 10. It includes both internal and external ads.



Installed behind driver – 33in high x 21in long, placed in 30 buses, 110,000 estimated impressions.



External - 2.5ft high x 12ft long, installed on 25 buses, 1.5M estimated impressions.
