APPENDIX A

- 1. Prior to July 21, 2009, the Seattle Ethics Code, SMC 4.16.070.1.c provided that no City officer or employee shall "[f]ail to disqualify himself or herself from acting on any transaction which involves the City and any person who is, or at any time within the preceding twelve (12) month period has been a private client of his or hers, or of his or her firm or partnership."
- 2. Effective July 21, 2009, the Seattle Ethics Code, SMC 4.16.070.1.b, provides that a Covered Individual may not "[p]articipate in a matter in which a person that employed the Covered Individual in the preceding 12 months, or retained the Covered Individual or his or her firm or partnership in the preceding 12 months, has a financial interest."
- 3. The Seattle Ethics Code, SMC 4.16.070.2.a states that no Covered Individual may "use or attempt to use his or her official position for a purpose that is, or would to a reasonable person appear to be primarily for the private benefit of the Covered Individual or any other person, rather than primarily for the benefit of the City."
