Introductions

The August 2022 meeting minutes were reviewed and approved with no edits.

Update on Work Progress, Reports and Safety

Work Progress

The project is 45% complete. They're working on the big tank and are readying it for a pour in October. Upcoming trades on site include waterproofing, ironworkers, carpenters, and laborers. There are just under 50 workers on site each day, which will continue through the end of the year. More workers will be on site next spring.

Toward end of year, work includes smaller tanks, elevated decks, and stripping the large tank and setting acrylics. Early next year, they'll start on roof beams. Due to coordination with Hoffman on the Overlook Walk and Gary Merlino on Alaskan Way, MEP work has been rescheduled to early next year. Once Gary Merlino reroutes Alaskan Way, they'll work in that area.

Turner will continue providing CWA onboarding sessions to subcontractors. Turner is using the worker dispatch processes where they can. They'll look into pre-apprentices on site and will connect with Jon. Lisa recommended Turner look for more opportunities for women.

The City thanked Turner for giving the Ironworkers Pre-Apprenticeship program and City staff a tour of the project. Drew reiterated the site visit invite to all pre-apprenticeship programs.

Safety

Turner had first recordable on the project; it was a cut finger earlier this month. There have been no COVID cases recently. The safety team is offering KN-95 masks to workers when wildfire smoke decreases air quality.

Pre-apprenticeship Updates

ANEW/PACE are graduating a women cohort on September 28 in Tukwila, from 11-1. This year's last PACE co-ed cohort started two weeks ago, with 27 students enrolled. Mock interviews are October 12, and graduation is the first week of December. They're interested in becoming electricians, laborers, and carpenters. A Snohomish County cohort started two weeks ago. A Pierce County cohort started yesterday. The last women cohort of the year starts October 11.

Jon noted that he'd be happy to connect contractors on the projects to pre-apprenticeship programs and their graduates.
