SEATTLE VR/AR STARTUP RAISES \$14 MILLION IN INVESTMENTS


Pixvana, a Seattle startup, recently announced a \$14 million Series A investment from contributors Vulcan Capitol, Raine Ventures, Microsoft Ventures, Cisco Investments, and Hearst Ventures. The company was able to raise funds by pitching companies through a VR experience. Pixvana has developed a cloud-based end-to-end platform called SPIN Studio that helps virtual reality media makers edit, process, and deliver video at 8K resolution.
