1	7/18/2022	Q: I notice at the Racial Equity, there's no mentioned of API?	<b>A:</b> The data used to craft the theory of change framework in this process did not show a disproportionate representation of API community in programming. That does not mean that as a service provider who perhaps specializes in working with API folks, that you are not eligible for funding, nor does it mean that there isn't a high need in the local Asian community for these services. The theory of change is a tool for us to be accountable for understanding where service gaps exist and where we can work towards better, more culturally competent solutions as a funding office. If you specialize in providing services to the API community, we encourage you to apply for this RFQ.
