
Street View of 3835 S. Edmunds



Description of Proposed Work







Fence Column: Mutual Materials; Face Brick; "Baker's White" color.



National Hardware Black Gate Latch



Patio Hardscape: Mutual Materials; Roman Clay Pavers; "Pioneer Used" color



Fence Wood Panel: Cabot Stain; Semi-Solid Opacity; "Taupe" color.

Material: Cedar wood planks and 4x4 posts with concrete footings
