

# WING LUKE MUSEUM

## PLAN SET

November 14, 2024

### Description of Proposed Work

Wing Luke Museum is proposing a small mural to honor the memory of Samuel (Sam) Green, who was killed outside the museum staff entrance. Museum staff have been working with the family and artist to create an artwork that we hope will honor Sam's life and bring healing to the space.

No demolition required. No removal of existing features needed.

### Site Location & Photos

The mural will be on the Wing Luke Museum building, 719 South King Street. The nearest intersection is South King Street and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The mural will be painted on the blank wooden panel between the building's staff entrance and loading dock garage door.

There will be no changes or alterations to the floor or sidewalk, no construction required, there is no current landscaping, nor are there plans to add landscaping.

### Colors/Finishes

The mural will be painted with acrylic and/or latex paints and coated with a UV protection/graffiti resistant clear coat.

### Existing Conditions


See Attachment 1 for photographs of the site's current conditions. The site is a clean wooden panel, painted a deep brown that matches the look and feel of the entire building.
