


At its meeting of December 11, 2002 the Pike Place Market Historical Commission approved the following:

Change of location and expansion of use for a retail clothing store specializing in the sale of outerwear (coats, suits, jackets, sweaters, scarves, tops and accessories; 75% of display space) and supplemental craft merchandise (items made of clay, metal, fiber, glass and wood; 25% of display space). Expansion of use to include the sale of jewelry. Display space to be divided as follows: outerwear 70%; supplemental craft merchandise 20%; jewelry 10%.
