FACILITY UPDATE

Childbirth Center

- > Anticipate construction starting late fall 2019, contingent on permitting.
- > 3 phased construction to be completed by summer, 2021.

2 East Remodel

Behavioral Health

- > 3 safe rooms / triage area in the ED (planning underway)

2017-2018 MASTER PLAN ANNUAL REPORT

- Northwest Hospital continues to work diligently to consistently meet the goals and conditions of the approved Master Plan. A particular focus is meeting the meeting the goals of the Transportation Management Plan (TMP).
 - > TMP goal of 35% non-single occupancy trips during peak times vs NWH's current rate of 25.7%. Initiatives are underway aimed at achieving the TMP goal.
- Northwest Hospital continues to have a strong charity care program. During FY16, Northwest Hospital charity care deductions totaled \$13.3M.
- Status of projects which were initiated or under construction during the previous year: *There were no new projects impacting the Master Plan.*
- The institution's land and structure acquisition, ownership and leasing activity outside of but within two thousand five hundred feet (2,500') of the MIO District boundary: *There was no such activity for this reporting period*.
