## 2022 Annual Report

#### Development Activity

- Completion of Sinegal Center and Bannan renovations occurred in FY22 but were presented in last year's annual meeting
- No other new development plans in progress

#### Leases

- Lab space lease terminated at PNRI (720 Broadway)
- Center for Community Engagement relocated from Douglas to Sinegal; lease in Douglas building terminated

#### Future work


- Continuing design work on Marion Entrance adjacent to Sinegal
- Anticipation of early termination of Rianna lease



# 2022 Annual Report

#### Transportation:


- March 2020 commute survey indicated
   21.8% drive-alone rate, below 35% MIMP target
  - Remote work policies in place at that time continued to affect these numbers.
- Commute survey conducted in Fall 2022 (FY23); results will appear in FY23 report later this year
- Coordination with Bus Rapid Transit project team to understand impacts

## 1300 Columbia Update

- Final Inspection/Certificate of Occupancy issued on 3/2/22
  - Closeout after 'Post-Occupancy Monitoring' phase on 3/1/23 (standard permit process but not a required step for this permit)
- East façade painted Summer 2022
- Parking lot screening memo issued 3/14/2023



### Graffiti Removal

- If you see graffiti on SU-owned properties, the fastest way to have it removed is to call SU's Public Safety Non-Emergency line at (206) 296-5990
- City's graffiti complaint system operates slower and adds administrative burden to City and SU staff. SU's full-time paint shop staff can frequently address the problem before the City can issue a notice.
