The Seattle School District plans to build an addition and renovation to West Woodland Elementary School. The District is requesting modifications for 1) greater than allowed building height; 2) reduced setbacks for building and site structures in the north and south; 3) reduction of on-site parking; 4) addition of bicycle parking; 5) addition of an electric message board.

The process for considering this request includes hearings before an advisory committee composed of neighbors and School District and City representatives. The Committee can recommend departures and any relevant conditions to be applied to minimize their impacts or recommend denial. The Committee may make its recommendation following this meeting or hold up to two additional meetings prior to making its recommendation.
