The City of Seattle Office of Inspector General (OIG) has identified potential violations of Department policy by you. These potential violations arose from information and evidence obtained in the investigation of 2023OPA-0286. As these allegations are grounded in the same nucleus of facts and circumstances, OIG will retain oversight of this matter and it will be handled by the same investigator, Shayda Le, of Barran Liebman LLP under case number 2024OIG-0004. You may be interviewed or asked to provide information to help assess the facts of the case.

It is alleged that during the investigation of 2023OPA-0286 you provided untruthful information, did not cooperate fully with the investigation by providing a disguised handwriting sample, and improperly disclosed information about the investigation after an admonishment from OIG staff in your interview stating, "To maintain confidentiality of this investigation, you are ordered by authority of the Chief of Police, not to disclose information pertaining to this investigation except with your representative or attorney."

The facts and circumstances of the incident referenced in this notice shall be kept confidential and may not be discussed with any other individuals except your attorney or recognized representative. This does not preclude the disclosure of the existence of this complaint and your status as a named employee.
