OIG has reviewed the investigation for case number 2022OPA-0336 and appreciates OPA's additional effort in conducting second interviews with the named employees. This case can now be certified as both timely and objective.

As previously mentioned in OIG's February 27, 2023, Request for Additional Investigation Memo, this case cannot be certified as thorough because the named employees' displayed effort and care that were simply too lacking to exclude SPD's professionalism policy from the review of potential policy violations.
