OIG has reviewed the investigation for case number 2022OPA-0264. The investigation is certified as thorough, timely, and objective.

Importantly, while the 30-day notification for this case was one business day late, and typically would be considered untimely, because the NE was an unrepresented student officer who was terminated in 2022, the typical timelines can be more flexible.

Accordingly, and based on the totality of the circumstances, OIG is willing to consider this case timely, as well as thorough and objective.
