The named employee was arrested by another jurisdiction for sexual crimes.

INVESTIGATION

The OPA investigation included the following actions:

- 1. Review of the complaint notification
- 2. Review of the other jurisdictions report of the incident
- 3. Search for and review of all relevant records and other evidence
- 4. Review of court documents
- 5. Interviews of SPD employees

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

The named employee confessed to committing the sexual crimes and pled guilty to three felonies.
