# EJ Fund – PLEASE SHARE

- OSE to release the EJ Fund application TOMORROW, 8/20
- \$250,000 available to support community-led projects that benefit frontline communities
- Eligible applicants can apply for a \$10k or \$25k grant
  - Tribes & tribal organizations of any size
  - Nonprofits & community groups with an average operating budget of \$500k or less for the current & previous fiscal years
- Applications will be accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis until the total funding is awarded or by 5pm (PT) on October 20, 2024, whichever comes first.

# FEMA Grant for Libraries

- FEEMA Grant awarded for 5 Libraries
  - University
  - Columbia City
  - West Seattle
  - Queen Anne
  - Fremont
- These branches lack full cooling, and heat related closures impact these branches.
- These projects are typically part of larger projects that cover URM, ADA, and finish renewal needs.

# State LCIP Grant –Recommended for Award

- SPL and OSE collaborated on a Libraries Capital Improvement Program (LCIP) grant application, similar to the LCIP grant we secured in an earlier round for Green Lake Branch Library.
- Washington Department of Commerce is recommending funding for \$2M in support for the renovations and decarbonization at University Branch Library – 2025-2026 budget cycle.

# Green New Deal PET Funds

- \$610,000 recommended and granted to OSE MEEP
- \$400k sent to Parks
  - ✓ Northgate CC Heat Pump Water Heater
  - ✓ Montlake CC Heat Pump Water Heater
  - Rainier Beach CC Pool and Gym Mixing Fans
  - Rainier Beach CC Heat Pump Water Heater
  - High Point CC Gym Mixing Fans
  - Van Asselt CC Exterior LED Lighting
  - Jefferson CC Exterior LED Lighting

# GND Fund cont.

- Remaining \$210k is being used for grant match.
  - We have used/identified it previously for grants for which we did not receive an award.
  - Grant application is in process – grant focuses on bill savings
    - Two large LED Lighting projects at **Seattle Center Armory**
    - LED lighting at **Woodland Park Zoo** – Zoomazium, South Entrance
    - LED and Gas HVAC controls for **Magnuson CC Gym**

# Municipal Building Decarbonization

- Currently working on finalizing Municipal Building Decarbonization Strategy – due to be final in Q4 2024
- Update:
  - 20 buildings decarbonized since 2018
  - 33 additional buildings have been partially decarbonized
  - 176 to go
