Make Seattle free of climate pollutants that worsen climate change and harm human health and nature.



Prioritize investments in communities that are most harmed by economic, racial, and environmental injustice to foster healthy communities and environments for all.



Move towards a regenerative economy so that those who currently have the least amount of power and wealth have access to economic opportunities, stable and well-paying jobs with benefits.
