## **RESOLUTION 16**

A RESOLUTION relating to the 2017 Budget; carrying forward non-capital appropriations from the 2016 budget of the Seattle Park District.

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 35.61.040, formation of the Seattle Park District became effective and its boundaries established as of August 19, 2014, upon certification of results of the August 5, 2014 election; and

WHEREAS, RCW 84.09.030 provides that no property tax may be collected for any taxing district whose boundaries are not fixed as of August 1 of the calendar year preceding collection (i.e., August 1, 2014 for calendar year 2015 collections); and

WHEREAS, because the District's boundaries were not established prior to August 1, 2014, the first property tax collections for the District commenced in 2016; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 Adopted Park District Budget appropriated \$47,798,347, \$13,613,159 of which is appropriated to fund Park District operating initiatives (Resolution 6); and

WHEREAS, appropriations approved in the Park District budget for capital outlays remaining unexpended or unencumbered at the close of the fiscal year shall remain in full force and effect unless otherwise abandoned by the Park District Board of Commissioners via resolution; and

WHEREAS, appropriations provided in the Park District budget for operating and maintenance expenses that remain unexpended or unencumbered at the close of the fiscal year shall lapse unless otherwise authorized by the Park District Board of Commissioners via resolution; and

WHEREAS, Seattle Parks and Recreation and the Seattle Park District will not fully spend certain funds appropriated in the 2016 Adopted Budget; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SEATTLE PARK DISTRICT, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Of the total \$13,613,159 appropriated in 2016 to fund Park District operating initiatives, no more than \$925,000 of unspent funds so appropriated will carry forward to the subsequent fiscal year operating budget.
