WHEREAS, notice of the Seattle Park District's consideration of this resolution has been
provided in the usual manner for other proposed Seattle Park District resolutions; NOW,
THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SEATTLE PARK
DISTRICT, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1. Regular property taxes for collection in 2021 are authorized in the amount
reflected in the resolution introduced as District Resolution 40. Not including increases resulting
from the addition of new construction, construction of wind turbine, solar, biomass, and
geothermal facilities, if such facilities generate electricity; improvements to property; and any
increase in the value of state-assessed property, the regular property tax levy for 2021 collection
represents an increase above regular property taxes levied for collection in 2020 (excluding the
"refund fund levy" in both instances) of \$1,329,975, which is a 2.49 percent increase over the
previous year's levy of \$53,338,893.
