Lake Union Park at 860 Terry Ave. N offers:

- **Public moorage** for private vessels on the West Wall (day-use only, first come first served, 2 hour limit)
- **Guest moorage** for commercial and private vessels on the North Wall and Slip 1

Seattle Parks and Recreation is responsible for the Lake Union Wharf and The Center for Wooden Boats manages reservations and collects moorage fees. Fees for guest moorage are due at the time of reservation and are subject to change annually. 
