

JEFFERSON PARK GOLF COURSE NETTING PROJECT

INFORMATIONAL EVENT

Seattle Parks and Recreation is installing new netting on holes 11 and 12 at Jefferson Park Golf Course to reduce golf balls travelling out of the park.

During the Golf Master Plan process the errant ball issue around holes 11 to 12 at Jefferson Park Golf Course was identified. Seattle Parks and Recreation worked with Premier Golf and originally planned to reroute holes from a counter-clockwise pattern to a clockwise pattern, but as the design and permitting was further developed, we concluded that permitting requirements, loss of trees, extensive course closure to complete this work, loss of revenue, and overall project costs outweighed the option of installing netting.

We are now planning to install new higher netting along a portion of holes 11 and 12 to reduce golf balls travelling out of the park. Netting would be installed along 24th Ave. S. and S. Spokane St. Construction of the poles and netting will begin in early 2021 and be completed by summer 2021.
