Introduction

History:

- Magnolia Community Center was identified in 2016 Community Center Strategic Plan for a major maintenance project focused on extending the life of the facility and increasing programming potential
- Repairs prioritized for seismic, fire-safety and access improvements to serve the community the best and prolong the usefulness of the facility
- Planning started in Spring 2017
- Design and Permitting continued 2017-2023

Bidding Update

- (5) Companies submitted bids
- (3) Passed through Purchasing and Contracting Review
- Kassel & Associates, Inc was the low bidder and going through pre-approval
- Base Bid + Addendum #1 (Ceiling Tiles) were both accepted and came in slightly above Engineers Estimate.
- Intended award amount \$3,211,997

- Ceiling Tile Replacement
