



What is the Navigation Team?

- Navigation Team: City contracted outreach workers, police officers, and FAS field coordinators
 who work together to connect unsheltered people to shelter and critical resources, while
 helping address pervasive challenges around the issue of homelessness in Seattle
- Outreach: Conducted before, during, and after cleanups to identify & implement individual solutions that break down barriers preventing people from moving indoors

Encampment Cleanup Process:

- Reporting unauthorized encampments
- Assessment
- Prioritization
- Scheduling
- Notice
- Storage

Navigation Center:

- One of many shelter and service options across the City
- 24-hour, low-barrier shelter designed to connect homeless individuals to services and transition them to permanent housing
- The Navigation Team is the primary referral resource into the Navigation center
