




Neighborhood Greenways

Seattle is building a network of neighborhood greenways, protected bike lanes, and trails that work together with funding for bike parking, encouragement programs, and safety education, to make biking a healthy, affordable travel option for people of all ages and abilities.

As part of this work, we have been installing a Neighborhood Greenway on 21st Ave S, between S Columbia St and Washington Middle School. Previous work updated curb ramps and marked crosswalks at E Yesler Way, E Jefferson St, and E Cherry St, and paved sections of 21st Ave S.

In the coming weeks, we will update curb ramps at 21st and E Alder st, and at 21st and E Terrace St. Later this year, we will pave between E James St and E Spruce St. We will also add speed humps and new signage in some areas.
