


Aurora Ave Project



- Identify transit service improvement and connection needs
- Address the needs of residents, businesses, and corridor stakeholders

- As noted above, we'll continue the concept analysis, environmental review, community engagement, and design work needed to select a preferred alternative to move closer to implementation, as funding is available.


