

# Our solution so far

**1**



Book a ride via smartphone app, computer, or call center

(Ease of access)

**2**



Trained driver arrives with first available vehicle that meets rider's access needs

(Ease of access, safety/experience)

**3**



Drops off (or picks up) at nearest mass transit station (at a passenger loading zone)

(Safety/experience)



Seattle Tier 1 languages supported

(Ease of access)



Comes within 10-20 minutes

(Timeliness)



Free or deeply subsidized

(Affordability)






# Project Budget - Original


For context, the 2019 Rideshare to Transit pilot offered:

- **\$2.75-\$3.00** discounts
- On **15,469** total rides
- To **6,094** unique riders
- Over a **2-month** period (mid-Dec. 2018 to mid-Feb. 2019)
- Open to the general public


