

Pedestrian improvements coming to Kenyon Way S

We're excited to let you know that we're building new pedestrian improvements in your neighborhood. The Kenyon Way S Sidewalk Project is funded through the Seattle Department of Transportation's (SDOT) Safe Routes to School and Urban Trails and Bikeways Programs and will enhance safety to Wing Luke Elementary for kids and families and make it easier to walk and bike in the neighborhood.

TIMELINE

Construction in your neighborhood will begin as soon as January 2nd and last through April 2023.

PROJECT DETAILS

We are prioritizing this location to fill a gap in the sidewalk and urban trail network, enabling kids and families to walk safely to Wing Luke Elementary School by Spring 2023. Project elements include:

- new multi-use sidewalk with handrails and pedestrian lighting
- new curb ramps including a multi-use ramp to connect the Chief Sealth Trail
- two new seating areas on Kenyon Way S (part of the Kenyon Neighborhood Greenway)
- Wing Luke student artwork selected from a design competition will be installed along the new sidewalk

Once the project is complete, traffic circulation will change to one-way, eastbound on Kenyon Way S.

We appreciate your help as we work to make it easier to get around the neighborhood, and we hope you enjoy the completed project.
